

Tour Stop #7 – 339 Mapleview Drive



Jerry and Jessica Sommer moved their family to 339 Mapleview Drive in 2008, ten years after the home's construction in 1998. The situation on 15 acres at the end of a private drive provides plenty of space for outdoor activities. The five bedroom, four bath, 4,300 square foot home includes several surprises and a unique blend of style best described as traditionally modern.

The Sommer's have extensively reshaped the home's character throughout their time in residence, beginning with the transformation of the basement into a walk-out cocktail lounge, guest suite and den. Most recently they have refinished the master bath with a new lighting and textures including a unique linen-look ceramic tile. New flooring was installed throughout the home beginning with a beautiful Italian wood grain ceramic tile that greets you as you enter the foyer. Upstairs the Sommer's children, Angelica, 13, and Austin, 10, chose their own décor for the bedrooms.

The landscaping is all new this year, designed by Jerry's uncle, Jon Sommer, who also created the original landscape plans in 1997. Jerry has refinished the exterior with a smartly rustic combination of stone and exposed beams. Once again blending traditional with modern.

The most surprising feature is the stunning forest view through the oversized windows in the main room. The outdoor light, boldly muted color selections and thoughtful interior design create a very relaxed environment that nicely interacts with the outdoors where the family enjoys their own private pond and beach for swimming and skating.
